

Jasper Jiggle and the Shiny Things

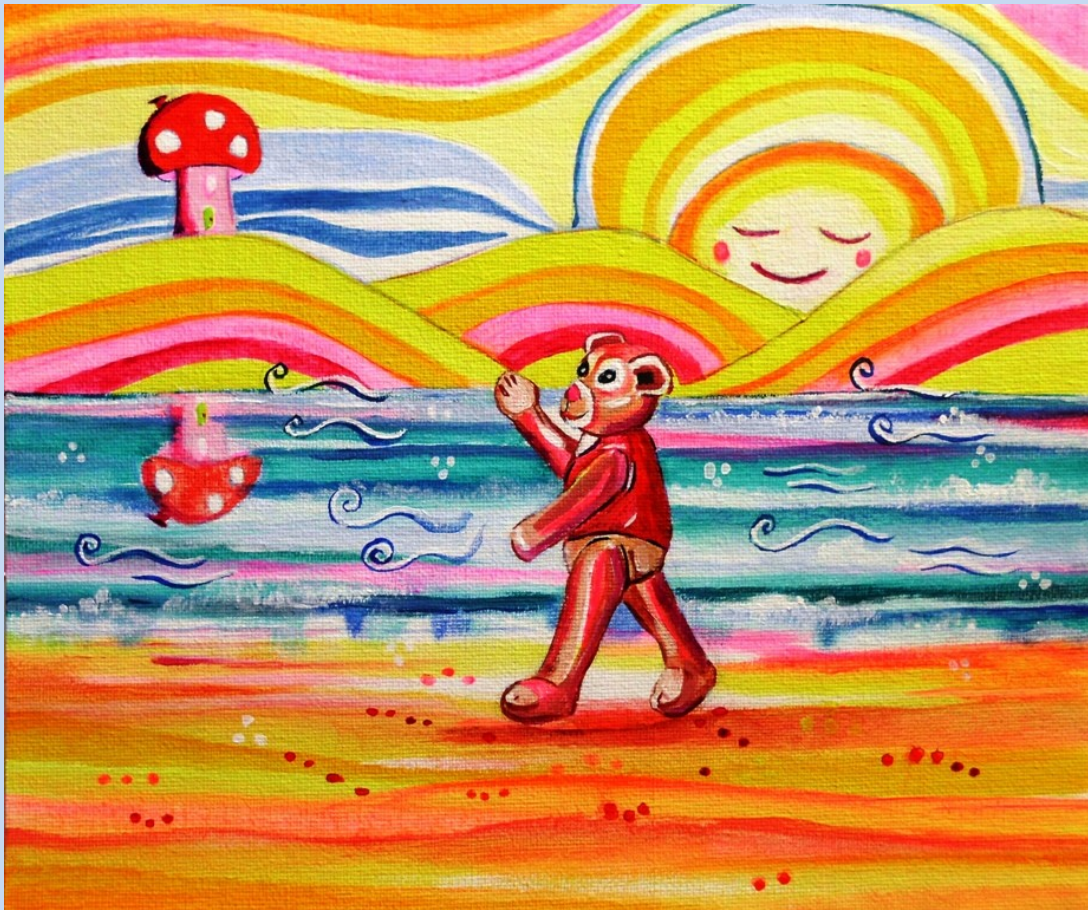
